On April 1, 2008, Hank Hultquist, Brian Benison, and Jack Zinman, representing AT&T Inc., (AT&T) met with Ian Dillner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin, to discuss the above-referenced dockets. In particular, we explained that regulatory uncertainty regarding the proper intercarrier compensation payments applicable to Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) traffic is distorting competition in the communications marketplace. Consistent with the positions AT&T has advocated in the above-referenced proceedings, we also discussed the Commission's substantive and procedural options for addressing VoIP intercarrier compensation issues in a manner that furthers the Commission's overall goals for comprehensive intercarrier compensation reform.
