

CERTIFICATION

For purposes of assisting in your station's compliance with the FCC regulations governing digital television (DTV) transition notices, 47 CFR Sec. 73.674, the **Univision Network** provides you with the following information regarding the DTV notices transmitted by the Network during the First Quarter of 2008.

On Monday, March 31, 2008, the Univision Network transmitted a total of 3 crawls, snipes or tickers (CSTs) related to the DTV transition. One CST ran in each of the following programs:

Casos de Familia, 10 - 11 am ET/PT, 9 - 10 am CT/MT.

El Gordo y La Flaca, 4 - 5 pm ET/PT, 3 - 4 pm CT/MT.

Cristina, 10 - 11 pm ET/PT, 9 - 10 pm CT/MT.

Also on Monday, March 31, 2008, the Univision Network transmitted a total of 3 PSAs related to the DTV transition. One PSA ran during each of the following programs:

Despierta America, 7 - 10 am ET/PT, 6 - 9 am CT/MT.

Noticiero Univision, 6:30 - 7:00 pm ET/PT, 5:30 - 6:00 pm CT/MT.

Noticiero Univision - Ultima Hora, 11:30 pm - 12:00 am ET/PT, 10:30 - 11:00 pm CT/MT (transmitted after 11:35 ET/PT, 10:35 CT/MT).

In addition to these notices, the Univision Network has already transmitted two separate 30 minute educational programs regarding the digital transition:

The Univision Network transmitted a half hour special, entitled "TV Digital...¿Que Tal?" ("Digital TV...What Is It?"), on December 1, 2007 at 4:30 pm ET/PT (3:30 pm CT/MT), on December 9, 2007 at 12:30 am ET/PT (December 8, 2007 at 11:30 pm CT/MT), and on February 2, 2008, at 11:00 am ET/PT (10:00 am CT/MT). The program explained in easy to understand terminology the differences between analog and digital broadcasting and detailed the government's coupon program for the purchase of digital-to-analog converter boxes. The special was hosted by Univision Network personalities and featured Carmen Scanlon of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, Federal Communications Commission and Carlos Gutierrez, the U.S. Secretary of Commerce.

The Univision Network transmitted another half hour special, entitled "TV Digital...¿Cuanto Sabes?" ("Digital TV... How Much Do You Know?"), on March 22, 2008, at 4:30 pm ET/PT (3:30 pm CT/MT), and again on March 30, 2008 at 1:30 am ET/PT (12:30 am CT/MT). The special, hosted by and featuring various Univision Network personalities, again reviewed the differences between analog and digital broadcasting, highlighted the benefits of digital broadcasting, explained the importance of applying for digital-to-analog converter box coupons and demonstrated, step-by-step, how to properly install a converter box. In this special, Cristina Saralegui, host of Univision's popular talk show "Cristina" interviewed Alex Nogales, president of the National Hispanic Media Coalition, who discussed the importance of the digital conversion and the viewers who will be affected by this change.
