Re: Request for Waiver of Section 73.674

Dear Ms. Dortch:

MTB San Francisco Licensee LLC ("MTB San Francisco"), the licensee of Station KCNS(TV), San Francisco, California (Facility ID No. 71586), by its attorneys, hereby requests a brief waiver of and/or an extension of time within which to comply with the obligation to broadcast the DTV transition crawls required by Section 73.674 of the Commission's Rules.

MTB San Francisco fully intends to comply with the DTV Consumer Education Initiative requirements adopted in MB Docket No. 07-148. However, MTB San Francisco is unable to generate the DTV transition crawls at this time. MTB San Francisco has ordered and received delivery of the CODI equipment necessary to generate those crawls, and expects that equipment to be installed and operating by Thursday, April 3, 2008. MTB San Francisco notes that it is broadcasting at this time the DTV transition public service announcements as required by Section 73.674.

In light of the expedited effective date of the DTV Consumer Education Initiative rules, and MTB San Francisco's good faith effort to both order and install that equipment as quickly as possible, MTB San Francisco respectfully requests a brief waiver of and/or an extension of time within which to comply with the obligation to broadcast DTV transition crawls until such time as it has the equipment installed to do so.
