I, David S. Weber, certify that I am an officer of the company named above, and acting as an agent of the company, that I have personal knowledge that the company has established operating procedures that are adequate to ensure compliance with the Commission's CPNI rules. See 47 CFR 64.2001 et seq.

DQE has operating procedures in place to protect CPNI which comply with 47 CFR 64.2001, et seq. Specifically, it is DQE's policy to release CPNI **only** upon receiving the express written consent of the customer. Furthermore, because of the nature of DQE's customers and its services, the CPNI to which DQE could have access is extremely limited, if it exists at all. DQE provides point-to-point lit-fiber services on a common carrier basis to ten customers, all of which are governmental entities. DQE does not provide local exchange, exchange access, interexchange, or toll services, either by wireless or wireline facilities. DQE's point-to-point lines are provided to governmental entities under contracts awarded through public bidding and/or decisions made at public meetings. Accordingly, information regarding the type, quantity, technical configurations, location and destination of DQE's telecommunication services are a matter of public record and not CPNI at all. DQE does not create or maintain records of the amount of traffic that it carries on private point-to-point lit fiber lines dedicated to customer use.

The Company has not taken any actions against data brokers in the past year. DQE has no information to report with respect to the processes pretexters are using to attempt to access CPNI, and what steps companies are taking to protect CPNI.
