On April 15, 2008, Julian Shepard and Jerry Kilgore of Williams Mullen, representing the Consumer Coalition for Competition in Satellite Radio (“C3SR”), met with Ms. Amy Blankenship, Legal Advisor for Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate, regarding C3SR’s opposition to the merger. C3SR reiterated that the merger applications should be denied, but if granted, the need for a structural remedy with accompanying conditions to ensure that SDARS competition is restored quickly is imperative.
