iBiquity Digital Corporation (“iBiquity”), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, of a meeting held on April 15, 2008 with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate and Amy Blankenship of Commissioner Tate’s office. iBiquity was represented by Albert Shuldiner (General Counsel) of iBiquity.

At this meeting, iBiquity reviewed its proposal to require satellite radios that are able to receive analog AM and FM signals also include the ability to receive the terrestrial digital radio signals specified in MM Docket No. 99-325. iBiquity explained that this proposal will help promote the development of a level playing field between satellite and terrestrial digital radio.
