On April 16, 2008, the undersigned, along with Kevin McGinnis, Vice-Chairman of the PSST; Alan Caldwell, Secretary-Treasurer of the PSST; Steven Kaufman of Hogan & Hartson LLP, counsel to the PSST; Morgan O'Brien and David Knutson of Cyren Call; and Elizabeth Sachs of Lukas, Nace, Gutierrez & Sachs, counsel to Cyren Call; met with Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps.
