Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Tuesday, April 21, 2008, Lawrence Krevor, Vice President, Government Affairs – Spectrum, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”); James Goldstein, Director – Spectrum Reconfiguration Projects, Sprint Nextel; and I met with Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff & Senior Legal Advisor, Wireless & International, to Commissioner Robert McDowell.

At the meeting, we provided an update on the progress made in reconfiguring the 800 MHz band. We noted that nearly five hundred public safety licensees have filed requests for extensions of time or waiver of the June 26 deadline, stating that they will be unable to complete retuning by that date. We explained that, despite the progress made in rebanding, for reasons outside Sprint Nextel’s control, a number of retunings will not be completed by the June 26, 2008 rebanding deadline.
