Dear Chairman Martin,

I am writing in support of Clear Channel Radio in Tucson, Ariz.; its stations KRQQ, KOHT, KXEW, KWMT, KTZR and KNST; and the company's association with Tucson Medical Center (TMC), its Children's Miracle Network, and TMC Foundation. Over the past five years, these stations have, without fail, supported the fund-raising efforts of the Children's Miracle Network at TMC.

TMC's Children's Miracle Network is dedicated to raising funds to improve the quality of care that we provide to infants, children, and their families in Southern Arizona. The money raised stays right here to support wellness programs, purchase life-saving equipment and provide health services for our children at Tucson Medical Center, the region's largest hospital.

In support of our community's children, KRQQ hosts the annual "KRQ Children's Miracle Network Cares for Kids Radiothon."
