

NRECA experienced a technical issue filing reply comments in the pole attachment proceeding late last evening. Only a portion of our comments were ultimately uploaded to the FCC's website. Unfortunately, the first section - the comments themselves - never were not successfully posted. Otherwise, about 100 pages of declarations and accompanying photographs were posted as comments.

To the best of my understanding, an attempt was made to post the comments and photographs as one large file, but was kicked back for being too large. The filing was then broken down into multiple smaller files. The first section uploaded (attached to this e-mail) contained the comments, the first declaration and some photos. While immediate confirmation was received from the FCC website that this file/section was accepted, this is the one section that does not show up on the website today. After filing the first section, the second section containing photographs and declarations was uploaded. Again, this file was kicked back as being too large, so it was broken up into two parts and filed again. Apparently the first file (which had already been confirmed as received) was retroactively deleted when the second file was rejected. Not knowing this, we continued filing the photos and declarations and ultimately received confirmation of those filings as well. Apparently, there was no notice from the FCC website that the first file had been retroactively deleted when the second file was rejected. Due to the delay between uploading and actually being posted to the website, we did not notice the discrepancy until this morning.

Attached is the first section that apparently never got through. It has the comments, the declaration of Bert Champion and some of his accompanying photos. I've attached this file for uploading with the others. If this e-mail is not sufficient explanation to get the missing piece posted with the balance of the comments, please advise me on how to proceed.
