**DECLARATION OF PRAGASH PILLAI**

1. My name is Pragash Pillai. I am Vice President Strategic Engineering for Bresnan Communications, LLC ("Bresnan"). I declare under penalty of perjury that the facts contained in this Declaration are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, and that I am authorized to give this Declaration on behalf of Bresnan. This Declaration replaces my Declaration filed in this proceeding with Bresnan's First Amended Waiver Request filed December 14, 2007.

2. Pursuant to the Memorandum Opinion and Order ("Order") issued by the Bureau in this proceeding on April 16, 2008, Bresnan hereby accepts the conditional waiver from the integration ban as set forth therein. Accordingly, Bresnan publicly commits to the following plan by this sworn declaration: it will (1) transition its Gillette, Wyoming system to all-digital on or before February 17, 2009; (2) notify all of its analog customers in Gillette of the transition within 60 days of the release of the Order, and again six months before completing the transitions, and each time submit sworn declarations to the Commission confirming that such notice has been provided; (3) within 60 days of the release of the Order, ensure that it has in its inventory or has placed orders for enough set-top boxes to ensure that each of its customers in Gillette can continue to view video programming on their television sets after the transition, and submit a sworn declaration to the Commission confirming that this is the case.
