I am writing this letter in response to the proposed changes to the FCC regulations regarding Christian radio broadcasting. I currently am a monthly financial supporter of K-Love Christian radio. I am in opposition to any legislation that would interfere with any Christian radio messages because of having one board that would oversee all broadcasters in an area as not all appointed individuals may be friendly to the Christian mission of the station.

I am in opposition to any legislation that that would cost each affected station more money to broadcast, even some smaller facilities which might ultimately force them to leave the air in some areas.

I am in opposition to any legislation that would give priority to new low power FM (LPFM) stations rather than existing translator stations so that they would no longer be able to carry the Christian programming that they currently are carrying.

I respectfully request that any changes such as the above mentioned be discontinued and that Christian radio be allowed to continue broadcasting unhindered.
