On April 24, 2008, James Blitz, Craig Wadin and Doug Ayerst of XM Radio Inc. ("XM"), Alan Pate and Terrence Smith of Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. ("Sirius"), Michael Lewis of Wiley Rein LLP, technical consultant for Sirius, and Peter Rohrbach of Hogan & Hartson LLP, counsel for XM, met with Robert Nelson, Stephen Duall, and Shabnam Javid of the International Bureau. Representatives from XM and Sirius discussed the technical issues arising in the above-captioned proceedings as summarized in the attached document, which was provided to the International Bureau representatives in attendance.
