Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 24, 2008, R. Michael Senkowski, Jennifer Hindin, and Brendan Carr of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to Iridium Satellite LLC (“Iridium”), met with Wayne Leighton of Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate’s office. In this meeting, the participants reviewed the Commission’s decision to modify the Big LEO bandplan to provide CDMA and TDMA systems exclusive access to 7.775 MHz of spectrum in the 1610-1626.5 MHz band.¹

In this meeting, the participants discussed the relevant issues in this docket and counsel for Iridium responded to Globalstar’s recent *ex parte* letter.² Consistent with Iridium’s previous positions and *ex parte* filings,³ counsel for Iridium discussed the FCC’s authority to regulate the space station segment of Globalstar’s operations and the effects of the *Second Order on Reconsideration* on Globalstar’s operations outside the United States.
