**Re: MB Docket No. 07-57 and 00-168**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 25, 2008, David Rehr and Marsha MacBride of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB") met with Commissioner Michael Copps and Rick Chessen to discuss the proceedings described below.

NAB expressed our concerns that the pending merger of XM Satellite Radio Holdings, Inc. and Sirius Satellite Radio, Inc. (MB Docket No. 07-57) will harm consumers, undermine fair competition in local radio markets, and violate the Commission's long-standing prohibition against a merger of the nation's only two satellite radio licensees. NAB also warned against the creation of a regulated satellite radio monopoly subject to conditions, given the applicants' record of violations of the Commission's rules.

Commissioner Copps also raised the matter of NAB's Petition for Review of the Commission's decision in the Enhanced Disclosure Proceeding (MB Docket No. 00-168).<sup>1</sup> NAB explained that association members have informed the NAB that new FCC Form 355 is unduly burdensome.
