

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Free Press has encouraged strong public participation in this proceeding since the Commission requested public comment on the Petition of Declaratory Ruling submitted by Free Press et al. and released for comment on January 14, 2008. We provided interested citizens with a mechanism to easily submit their opinions to the FCC on this matter. In facilitating public input, an error occurred which caused the bulk of the comments utilizing our mechanism to be submitted to WC Docket No. 07-54. Given that there were only sixty comments intended for WC Docket No. 07-54 with the last comment dated September 6, 2007, we've determined that 26,457 additional comments that were submitted to WC Docket No. 07-54 starting on January 16, 2008 were misfiled.

Free Press would like apologize for the inconvenience that this may have created. We would like to notify the Commission that we will be resubmitting these comments filed through our online action mechanism into WC Docket No. 07-52, in order to accurately capture the massive involvement from the public in this proceeding. Free Press will be submitting 50 documents, compiling the signatures from each state. We invite the Commission to consider the voices of more than twenty six thousand Americans when deliberating the facts in the proceeding. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.
