

K-Love Radio is very important to me and to my family. Having access to uncompromisingly sincere Christian radio helps us to be a stronger family, as well as to be stronger individuals. My Christian faith is very important to me, and the messages that K-Love shares on its radio programming are very encouraging and supportive to my faith. They play consistently moral and clean music, which is very hard for me to find on most other radio stations. I oppose the move to require community advisory boards, reporting by the station about the type of programming a radio station is producing, forced sharing of airtime for different groups, license renewal by FCC commissioners and not qualified civil servants, elimination of technology that allows staffless operation of the station, and relocation of stations' main facilities. It is clear to me that all of these requirements would place added financial and airtime restrictions on K-Love and similar broadcasters that could drive them out of business, or cause them to greatly reduce the content that I find so beneficial--namely, sharing their faith in Christ and playing outspokenly Christian music.

Please do not take these regulational measures, and please continue to allow K-Love and other stations to share their encouraging messages uninhibited.
