How you got my name is a mystery to me but I truly felt blessed. I do work at the school my children attend but the money just covers our basic needs there's never been any room for the extras.


I just wanted to let you know how much your kindness and generosity was appreciated and that you made two very deserving children feel special. Something I hope they realize more and more in their lives.


