Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 28, 2008, Tom Kigin of Minnesota Public Radio/American Public Media and Jonathan Schwantes of Clark & Weinstock met with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, to discuss American Public Media's previously filed comments regarding the XM-Sirius license transfer review proceeding (MB Docket No. 07-57).

American Public Media restated arguments consistent with its comment filed on April 24, 2008, and urged the Commission to impose a 20 percent set aside condition for non-commercial educational use upon the license transfer in order to satisfy the public interest.

Minnesota Public Radio/American Public Media also alerted Mr. Chessen to its comment filed on April 28, 2008 in the localism proceeding (MM Docket No. 04-233) and briefly discussed the concerns raised in that filing.
