AS PROSPECTIVE JURORS ARRIVED MONDAY MORNING, SO DID STUDENTS FROM FLORIDA STATE AND FLORIDA A&M UNIVERSITIES, LINING-UP IN FRONT OF THE MARINA CIVIC CENTER.

"WE'RE JUST HERE TO PROTEST AND SHOW OUR SUPPORT FOR THE ANDERSON FAMILY"

"WE CAME TO GET JUSTICE FOR MARTIN LEE"

"EVEN THOUGH IT WAS NOT CONSIDERED A SILENT PROTEST, THE STUDENTS DID NOT NEED TO SAY MUCH TO GET THEIR POINT ACROSS."

THEIR SIGNS AND THEIR APPAREL SENT OUT A STRONG MESSAGE, BUT THE STUDENTS INSIST THEY DO NOT WANT TO INCITE VIOLENCE.

"THIS SIGN IS A REFLECTION OF THE BRUTALITY THAT WAS BESTOWED ON MARTIN LEE ANDERSON. IT'S AS IF HE HAD THIS SIGN ON HIM AT A PARTICULAR POINT AND TIME WHEN HE WAS ASSAULTED."

ANOTHER POSTER USED A STILL PICTURE FROM THE WIDELY SEEN BOOT CAMP SURVEILLANCE VIDEO, WHICH WILL BE A CRUCIAL PART OF THE TRIAL.

"THE TAPE IS EVIDENCE. I BELIEVE THE GUARDS ARE GUILTY AND THE NURSE AS WELL."

"HAVE YOU SEEN THE TAPE? CAUSE I SAW IT. IT'S NOT A MATTER OF WHAT I THINK, IT'S A MATTER OF WHAT I SAW...THE PHOTOGRAPHS ARE CLEAR EVIDENCE. I SAY THEY ARE GUILTY."

IT WAS AN EMOTIONAL SECOND DAY AT THE MARTIN LEE ANDERSON BOOT CAMP CASE.

FOR OVER AN HOUR, THE COURT ROOM SAT IN COMPLETE SILENCE AS PROSECUTORS PLAYED THE ENTIRE SURVEILLANCE VIDEO LEADING UP TO THE INCIDENT BETWEEN 14 YEAR OLD MARTIN LEE ANDERSON AND THE 8 FORMER BOOT CAMP EMPLOYEES CHARGED WITH HIS DEATH.

THIS LAID THE GROUND WORK FOR THURSDAY'S TESTIMONIES FROM MEDICAL EXPERTS.

THE CAUSE OF DEATH OF MARTIN LEE ANDERSON IS THE CENTER OF THIS TRIAL.

THE CONSENSUS? THERE IS NO ONE CAUSE.

"DID MARTIN ANDERSON HAVE SICKLE CELL TRAIT?" "YES." "DO YOU BELIEVE IT WAS A CONTRIBUTING FACTOR TO HIS DEATH? IT WAS ONE OF THE MULTIPLE FACTORS YOU LISTED EARLIER?" "YES."

DR. THOMAS ANDREW IS THE CHIEF MEDICAL EXAMINER FOR THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE.

HE SAYS ANDERSONS' PRE-EXISTING CONDITION OF SICKLE CELL TRAIT CONTRIBUTED TO HIS DEATH.

BUT HE TESTIFIED THERE WERE SEVERAL OTHER FACTORS, INCLUDING THE USE OF AMMONIA CAPSULES AND THE GUARDS COVERING ANDERSON'S MOUTH.

"MARTIN LEE ANDERSON'S HEMATOLOGICAL CONDITION IS A CONTRIBUTOR TO HIS DEATH BUT HIS CAUSE OF DEATH IS MUCH MORE COMPLEX THAN ONE OR THE OTHER OF THESE DIAGNOSIS. I STAND BY MY CAUSE OF DEATH AND I WOULD DEFER TO DR. EICHER IN MATTERS OF HEMATOLOGY BUT IF HE WERE TO PREFER A CAUSE OF DEATH WITHOUT TAKING INTO ACCOUNT OTHER FACTORS INVOLVED. I WOULD VIGOROUSLY BUT RESPECTFULLY DISAGREE

DR. NIKOLAUS GRAVENSTEIN, CHAIR OF THE ANESTHESIOLOGY DEPARTMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, HAD A SIMILAR OPINION.

HE BELIEVES ANDERSON DIED FROM LACK OF OXYGEN, CAUSED BY A COMBINATION OF FACTORS: HIS AIRWAYS BEING OBSTRUCTED, EXERCISING, DEHYDRATION, AND SICKLE CELL TRAIT, BUT HE FEELS THE GUARDS ACTIONS ONLY MADE A BAD SITUATION WORSE.

"I BELIEVE THE ACTION ONE SEES ON THE VIDEO DIDN'T HELP HIM GET ANY BETTER. THEY DON'T SEE THAT HE IS STRUGGLING"
