Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 29, 2008, Tom Kigin of American Public Media, Jonathan Schwantes of Clark & Weinstock, and Sandi Stuart of Clark & Weinstock met with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor, to discuss American Public Media's previously filed comments regarding the XM-Sirius license transfer review proceeding (MB Docket No. 07-57).

American Public Media restated arguments consistent with its comments filed on April 24, 2008, and urged the Commission to impose a 20 percent set aside condition for non-commercial educational (NCE) use upon the license transfer in order to satisfy the public interest. Also discussed was how a set aside for NCE use would be structured.

American Public Media also alerted Commissioner Adelstein to the comments filed by its affiliated company, Minnesota Public Radio, on April 28, 2008 in the localism proceeding (MM Docket No. 04-233).

American Public Media briefly discussed the concerns raised in that filing, and urged that consideration be made for NCE stations and networks of stations providing wide area public radio service to lesser-populated areas.
