Pursuant to Section 1.1200, et seq., of the Commission's Rules, National Public Radio, Inc. ("NPR") hereby notifies the Commission of the following *ex parte* presentation in the above-referenced proceeding.

On Thursday, May 1, 2008, Michael Riksen, NPR's Vice President for Policy & Representation, and Mike Starling, NPR's Chief Technology Officer and Executive Director, NPR Labs, met with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps, regarding the proposed merger between XM Satellite Radio Holdings, Inc. and Sirius Satellite Radio, Inc. NPR restated its opposition to the proposed merger. The participants also discussed possible conditions the Commission might adopt if the Commission were to approve the proposed merger, including requiring the inclusion of terrestrial HD radio reception capability in SDARS receiving equipment.
