
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 1, 2008, Mr. David Donovan, president of the Association for Maximum Service Television ("MSTV") and Ann Bobeck, associate general counsel, Legal and Regulatory Affairs, National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB") met with Ms. Elizabeth Andrion in Chairman Martin's office, with regard to the above-captioned proceeding.

During the meeting, we discussed MSTV and NAB's request of a one-year delay in implementing the new FCC rule concerning PSIP update and programming overrun. We noted that the equipment is not yet available on the market to allow broadcasters to update programming material immediately.

Copies of MSTV's comments previously filed on the record were distributed at the meeting.
