On May 6, 2008, the undersigned from Google Inc. ("Google") met with Derek Poarch, Chief of the Commission's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, Erika Olsen, Deputy Chief of the Bureau, and John Branscome of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Discussions focused on various substantive and procedural issues that the Commission should consider as it finalizes its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) in the proceeding. In particular, Google raised a number of possible options concerning changes to the original spectrum band plans, revised bidding processes, commercial network requirements, the role of the Public Safety Broadband Licensee ("PSBL"), and elements of the Network Sharing Agreement ("NSA").
