I am writing in regard to the policies being proposed for radio stations in MB Docket No. 04-233. We are greatly concerned because these new regulations will seriously, negatively affect our local station, WLUJ-89.7 FM, in Springfield, Illinois. Also it could possibly force its sister stations, WRLJ-88.3 FM, White Hall, and WLWJ-88.1 FM, Petersburg, off the air. We would not want this to happen.

We are very pleased with the programming and performance of WLUJ, and we want it to continue as it is. It has helped us by giving good programs and services. It announces many community events and has made announcements for our church. We do not want them to have to reduce their hours or to increase their staff. They are doing a great job as it is.

A special concern of ours is that WLUJ would be forced to give away time to any community group that requested it. No station should be forced to broadcast programs with which they do not agree.

We also feel that the station personnel should not have the burden (taking time and finances) of being required to regularly send extra paperwork to the FCC about how the station is serving the community.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT THESE PROPOSED REGULATIONS IN PLACE!
Let these hard-working sacrificial people serve us effectively as they are now doing without these regulations.
