After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2007 Funding Commitment Decision Letter for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of USAC's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60 day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). If your Letter of Appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that you will receive a separate letter for each application.

Funding Request Number(s): 1565733, 1565836
Decision on Appeal: **Denied**
Explanation:

- Upon thorough review of the appeal letter and the relevant documentation, USAC has determined that Port Carbon Public Library failed to respond to the Program Integrity Assurance (PIA) inquiries in a timely manner. PIA made initial contact with Provida Masi, the applicant's authorized contact on April 27, 2007, via email and asked for verification required to correct the service provider contact information discrepancy. You were instructed that the request was time sensitive and that a response was expected within fifteen calendar days. The record shows that on May 7, 2007, PIA contacted and reminded you that the requested documentation due date was May 14, 2007. You failed to reply within a timely manner. As a result, the funding request was denied. On appeal, you were asked to address the service provider contact discrepancy. The Program Compliance reviewer contacted you via email on February 26 and March 5, 2008. The request

for information stated the discrepancy must be corrected within the allotted fifteen day period. As this information was not forthcoming, USAC was unable to determine if your funding requests were in compliance with Program Rules. You have failed to provide any evidence that USAC erred in its initial determination or that the Port Carbon Public Library responded to USAC's requests for additional documentation in a timely manner. Consequently, your appeal is denied.

- USAC reviews all program applications and makes funding commitment and disbursement decisions in compliance with FCC rules. See 47 C.F.R. sec. 54.500 et. seq. To conduct these reviews, USAC has put in place administrative measures to ensure the prompt resolution of applications. If applicants do not respond within the designated time period, USAC reviews the application based on the information before it. See Request for Review by Marshall County School District, Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service, Changes to the Board of Directors of the National Exchange Carrier Association, Inc., CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 97-21, 18 FCC Rcd. 4520, 4522, Order, DA 03-764 para. 6 (rel. Mar. 13, 2003). Typically applicants are required to respond to USAC's requests for additional information necessary to complete their application within 15 days of being contacted. See Request for Review of the Decision of the Universal Service Administrator by Bishop Perry Middle School, et.al., Schools and Libraries Universal Service Mechanism, CC Docket No. 02-6, Order, 21 FCC Rcd 5316-5317, FCC 06-54 para. 23 (rel. May 19, 2006). See also SLD section of the USAC website, Reference Area, "Deadline for Information Requests," www.usac.org/sl. For those instances where USAC contacts the applicant in reference to a Selective Review Information Request, the applicant is provided 30 days to comply with the request. This procedure is necessary to prevent undue delays during the application review process.

If your appeal has been approved, but funding has been reduced or denied, you may appeal these decisions to either USAC or the FCC. For appeals that have been denied in full, partially approved, dismissed, or canceled, you may file an appeal with the FCC. You should refer to CC Docket No. 02-6 on the first page of your appeal to the FCC. Your appeal must be received or postmarked within 60 days of the date on this letter. Failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of your appeal. If you are submitting your appeal via United States Postal Service, send to: FCC, Office of the Secretary, 445 12th Street SW, Washington, DC 20554. Thank you for your inquiry. You are listed as the Contact Person for SPIN 143024433, Wire Tele-View Corporation. You cannot be both the contact person for an applicant and for the Service Provider selected by that applicant. It is a violation of the program's competitive bidding rules. If you feel you are listed on this SPIN by mistake, or that you were denied funding unfairly, you have the option to file an appeal.

USAC recognizes that some Schools and Libraries Program (Program) participants will disagree with its decisions regarding Schools and Libraries funding commitments and disbursements. As is the case with any administrative decision made by USAC, affected parties to decisions made by USAC on billing, collection, or disbursement matters can seek an appeal of those decisions from USAC or directly with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The procedures for filing an appeal with USAC or the FCC are outlined below.

You may file an appeal with USAC or directly with the FCC.

Any appeal must be filed within 60 days of the issuance of the decision from USAC and must be postmarked within 60 days of that date. Pursuant to FCC rules, failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of the appeal. See Sections 54.719 to 54.725 of the FCC's rules for the details associated with filing an appeal.

Waiver Requests. A waiver is a request to waive an FCC policy, rule, or deadline such as the Form 471 application filing window deadline. For example, if you missed the filing deadline for Form 471 because of extenuating circumstances, USAC cannot waive the deadline but you can ask the FCC to waive the rules in your case by filing a waiver request with the FCC. To file a waiver request, follow the instructions for Option B below. Please note that waivers are not granted often: only in special circumstances and when a deviation from the rules would serve the public interest. The waiver standard generally requires a showing of circumstances that could not be avoided even with careful planning.

There are two appeal options:

- A. Write a Letter of Appeal to USAC explaining why you disagree with its decision and what outcome you request, OR;
- B. Write an appeal directly to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) - skipping Option A - explaining why you disagree with USAC's decision. While you may write directly to the FCC without first presenting your appeal to USAC, you are encouraged to write first to USAC so that it has an opportunity to resolve your appeal and grant it, if appropriate.

OPTION A - FILE AN APPEAL WITH USAC

Please follow these guidelines when submitting a Letter of Appeal to USAC:

Appeals submitted by email must be sent to appeals using your organization's email

account. Appeals submitted by email will be considered "postmarked" on a business day if they are sent from the sender's computer at any time up to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) in the sender's local time zone. Appeals submitted after that time will be considered "postmarked" on the next business day.

Documents submitted by email can be in any widely used word processing format, such as Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF), Microsoft Word, or WordPerfect. USAC will automatically reply to incoming emails to confirm receipt. You are advised to keep a copy of this email confirmation for your records. This email address can only be used for appeals.

Appeals submitted by fax must be sent to 1-973-599-6542. The fax transmission should include a cover sheet listing contact name, phone number, and - if available - an email address. Fax transmissions will be considered "postmarked" on a business day if the complete transmission is sent from the sender's fax machine by any time up to 12:00 a.m. (midnight) in the sender's local time zone. Appeals submitted after that time will be considered "postmarked" on the next business day. You are advised to keep a copy of your fax confirmation sheet for your records.

1. Provide detailed contact information.
2. Identify which USAC action you are appealing. Note the title of the document containing the USAC action you are appealing, the relevant Funding Year, and the date of the document. State that your letter is an "appeal."
3. Your letter of appeal must also include the Billed Entity Name, the relevant form application and Funding Request Numbers (if available), and the Billed Entity Number.
4. Explain your appeal and include copies of all relevant documentation. Please provide as much detailed information as possible. When explaining your appeal, copy the language or text from the decision that is at the heart of your appeal to allow USAC to more readily understand your appeal and respond appropriately. Please keep your letter to the point, and provide documentation to support your appeal. Be sure to keep copies of your correspondence and documentation.
5. Provide an authorized signature on your letter of appeal when you file your appeal by mail, by express delivery service, by hand delivery, or by facsimile. When you file your appeal, you must include the name, title, telephone number, and email, if available, of the authorized person.

Please note: The more detail you provide in your letter of appeal, the easier it will be for USAC to respond. However, USAC will thoroughly research your appeal and consider all the documentation you have submitted that relates to the decision you are appealing. For further guidelines, see Appeals Guidelines.

OPTION B - FILE AN APPEAL DIRECTLY WITH THE FCC

A Program participant may file an appeal directly with the FCC of a USAC decision or of USAC's response to a Letter of Appeal. The Program participant must file its appeal to the FCC within 60 days of the date of the USAC decision.

Please note that the FCC will usually dismiss an appeal if it is filed while USAC is reviewing the same appeal from you. You can file an appeal with the FCC instead of USAC or after USAC has issued its decision on an appeal request.

Indicate CC Docket No. 02-6 on the first page of your appeal.

If you are submitting a letter of appeal requesting review of a decision made by USAC, please use the language "Request for Review" on the first page.

If you are filing a request for a waiver of a deadline, please use the language "Request for Waiver" or "Waiver Request," so that it is clear what you request.

If you are alleging prohibitive conduct by a third party, there are additional rules for serving a copy on that third party and allowing them to respond. Consult 47 C.F.R. § 54.721, which can be found in Title 47 of the Code of Federal Regulations.


