On May 16, 2008, Susanne Guyer, Kathleen Grillo, Curtis Groves, Chris Miller, William Versen, and Raymond Wierzbicki of Verizon met with Dana R. Shaffer, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau, Marcus Maher, Associate Bureau Chief and Alex Minard, Legal Counsel to the Bureau Chief.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss InterCall's request for review of the Universal Service Administrative Company's decision requiring InterCall to contribute to the universal service fund ("USF") on its retail audio conferencing revenues and InterCall's related petition for a stay of contributions to the USF pending resolution of its appeal.

Verizon explained again that InterCall's failure to contribute to the USF on its retail audio conferencing revenues violates the Commission's rules. We urged the Bureau to take quick and decisive action to remedy the major competitive disadvantage that InterCall's conduct creates. It is critical that the Bureau immediately level the playing field and ensure that all providers are subject to the same rules.

Verizon repeated that it takes no position on InterCall's potential retroactive liability for contributions to the fund in prior years.
