This is to inform you that on May 19, 2008, Josh Silverman, CEO, Stephen Collins, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs - Global, and Christopher Libertelli, Senior Director, Government and Regulatory Affairs - North America, all of Skype Communications, S.A.R.L. ("Skype") met with Chairman Kevin J. Martin and Aaron Goldberger, Legal Advisor to Chairman Martin.
