On Monday May 19, 2008, Kathleen O'Brien Ham, Pamela Cook and Mark Combs of T-Mobile USA and Tom Dombrowsky (Engineering Consultant) of Wiley Rein LLP met with Blaise Scinto, David Hu, Jennifer Tomchin, Peter Daronco, Kevin Holmes, Brian Wondrack and Stephen Buenzow of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Geraldine Matise, Patrick Forster, Nick Oros and Jamison Prime of the Office of Engineering and Technology. In this meeting, T-Mobile urged the Commission to conclude consideration of the reconsideration issues in the above captioned docket that affect the relocation of Broadband Radio Service incumbents from the Advanced Wireless Service spectrum in the 2150 to 2155 MHz band and reiterated its concerns with pending reconsideration requests, consistent with past positions taken in the docket.
