On March 15, 2008, the following individuals, Gail Sanchez, Toni Acton and Penn Pfautz of AT&T, Jeff Rosen of Snap!VRS, Justin Nelson of Dash Carrier Services, George Sutcliffe, Edmond, Routhier and myself of GoAmerica and Hands On VRS met with the following Commission staff: Alan Amann, Nikki McGinnis, Cathy Seidel, and Thomas Chandler of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, Richard Hovey of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau and Nick Alexander of the Wireline Competition Bureau. The meeting focused on the attached presentation concerning numbering for Internet relay users.. The meeting outlined plans by several providers including AT&T, GoAmerica and Hands On to implement a demonstration project to provide a functional equivalent numbering system for deaf and hard of hearing users. The presenters also indicated that a number of other providers including Snap!VRS (also present) are engaged in discussions about the demonstration project.
