On May 21, 2008, Larry Page, President of Products and co-founder of Google Inc. (“Google”), along with Alan Davidson, Senior Policy Counsel, and the undersigned, met with Julius Knapp, Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology (OET), along with Geraldine Matise, Chief of OET’s Policy and Rules Division, and Rashmi Doshi, Chief of OET’s Laboratory Division, to discuss the TV white spaces proceeding. During the meeting Mr. Page explained that Google’s enhanced protection proposal was intended to provide the Commission with additional options for moving forward to allow unlicensed uses of portable devices. He also discussed possible power limits for using geolocation databases, the timing for spectrum sensing field trials, and the status of unregistered users of wireless microphones.
