Dear Ms. Dortch,

On behalf of Mid-Maine Telecom (the "Company"), and pursuant to the Commission's Report and Order CC Docket No. 02-33 (rel. Sept. 25, 2005) (the "Order"), we provide formal notification that the Company intends to offer wireline broadband Internet access transmission service on a de-tariffed basis. Consistent with the order, the terms and conditions of this service will be posted on its website ([www.mid-maine.com](http://www.mid-maine.com)) and will be generally available to prospective customers.

To effect this transition, the Company will request its removal from the list of carriers providing Digital Subscriber Line service under NECA Tariff F.C.C No. 5, effective no earlier than July 1, 2008 (Study Area No. 103315).

The Company has only one Digital Subscriber Line Service customer, and that customer is an affiliate of the Company. Notification to that affiliated customer was accomplished May 27, 2008 by e-mail. A copy of the notification is attached. In addition, a copy of this filing, including the notification, is being sent to the Governor of the State of Maine, the Maine Public Utilities Commission, and the Special Assistant for Telecommunications, Department of Defense. NECA is also being served with a copy of this notification.

Dear Mr. Winchester:

This letter provides formal notification that on or after July 1, 2008, Mid-Maine Telecom, Inc.(the "Company") will no longer offer tariffed DSL Access Services to the public in its ILEC serving area in Maine, an area including portions of Penobscot County. Currently, DSL Access Service is offered by the Company pursuant to its interstate access tariff, NECA F.C.C. Tariff No. 5. As required by the FCC, the Company will continue to offer services under the terms and conditions offered under the tariff on a grandfathered basis for a period of one year.

The DSL Access Services to be de-tariffed typically are used to provide high speed broadband transmission services to an internet service provider's end user customers. While we are not discontinuing this service, the rates, terms and conditions of service will no longer be provided under the NECA Tariff but instead will be posted on our website ([www.mid-maine.com](http://www.mid-maine.com)) and generally available to prospective customers.

These actions are taken in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order, released September 23, 2005, In the Matter of the Appropriate Framework for Broadband Access to the Internet Over Wireline Facilities. See FCC Document "FCC 05-150" and "FCC Docket 02-33".


