On May 30, 2008, the undersigned and Peter Corea, Mariam Sorond, and Sam Wetsel, for ICO Global Communications (“ICO”), along with Doug Hyslop and Tom Peters of Wireless Strategy, LLC, met with Joel Taubenblatt, Blaise Scinto, and Peter Daronco, of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; Ira Keltz, Jamison Prime, Nicholas Oros, and Pat Forster, of the Office of Engineering and Technology; and Paul Locke of the International Bureau. ICO reiterated comments filed on the record in the above-referenced proceedings, and noted the importance of technical rules that protect adjacent spectrum blocks from harmful interference. ICO also expressed concern that any Commission action in the pending proceedings should consider the potential impact on ICO’s 2 GHz mobile satellite system (“MSS”) and its planned ancillary terrestrial component.
