WT Docket No. 07-195 – Service Rules for Advanced Wireless Services in the 2155-2175 MHz Band (AWS-3)

WT Docket No. 04-356 – Service Rules for Advanced Wireless Services in the 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2000 MHz, 2020-2025 MHz and 2175-2180 MHz Bands (WT Docket No. 04-356) (AWS-2)

Dear Madam Secretary:

Rural Cellular Association (“RCA”), through counsel, submits this *ex parte* letter to urge the Commission to issue a public notice and to seek further public comment before adopting its proposed 25 MHz AWS-3 band plan. The current record contains conflicting evidence of the potential for interference under the previously noticed AWS-2 and AWS-3 band plan proposals. RCA members that purchased AWS spectrum in a prior Commission auction are concerned about the prospects for harmful interference to their operations. We note that the Commission provided no notice in either of the referenced dockets of an intention to consider reassigning 5 MHz of AWS-2 spectrum to the AWS-3 band. Because there has been no record developed regarding the potential for interference from a 25 MHz AWS 3 band plan, RCA respectfully suggests that the Commission allow for input to update the record rather than proceed as soon as June 19th to adopt service rules that may not withstand review. RCA does not oppose the proposed allocation; rather it appears premature for the Commission to adopt it before receiving comment on the specific proposal under review.
