On June 5, 2008, the undersigned spoke by phone with Dana Shaffer of the Wireline Competition Bureau. We discussed the importance of requiring Video Relay Service providers to be capable of and responsible for obtaining and maintaining the current IP addresses of consumers – in their respective databases and in the central database – for whom they provide 10-digit numbers, both for new numbers and for numbers ported by the consumer from another source/provider. There remains a pressing public interest need for Commission action on the numbering matter prior to the June 30, 2008 deadline and implementation of a numbering system prior to the December 31, 2008 deadline previously established by the Commission.
