Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 4, 2008, the undersigned and Peter Corea of ICO Global Communications (“ICO”), Doug Brandon of TerreStar Networks Inc. (“TerreStar”), and Tom Tycz, of Goldberg, Godles, Wiener and Wright for TerreStar, met with Chief of the Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”) Julius Knapp; Geraldine Matisse, Jamison Prime, Ira Keltz, Nicholas Oros, Patrick Forster, and Ahmed Lahjouji of OET; and Howard Griboff, Paul Locke, and Sankar Persaud of the International Bureau. ICO reviewed issues addressed in the attached presentation. TerreStar underscored the proximity of the proposed AWS bands to 2 GHz mobile satellite service (“MSS”) frequencies as outlined on the attached band diagram.

ICO and TerreStar reiterated comments filed on the record in the above-referenced proceedings. ICO and TerreStar also noted developments in the AWS-II docket since the closing of the comment period in that proceeding, and their impact on the potential for interference to its satellite and to mobile satellite user devices from adjacent band services. Both ICO and TerreStar urged that any Commission action in the pending proceedings consider the potential impact on 2 GHz MSS systems and planned ancillary terrestrial components.
