Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 4, 2008 John Muleta and the undersigned, on behalf of M2Z Networks, Inc., had a telephone conversation with Mr. Matthew Berry, General Counsel for the Federal Communications Commission. M2Z explained that there was ample notice of the combination of the AWS-2 and AWS-3 bands. M2Z further explained that it is well within the province of the Commission in its capacity as an expert agency to examine multiple spectrum bands with related interference concerns simultaneously and provide a more unified approach toward spectrum policy. Moreover, M2Z clarified that MetroPCS, in response to the AWS-3 NPRM, explicitly sought a combined consideration and auction of the AWS-2 and AWS-3 bands but is now claiming that the Commission lacks notice to make such a combination, a notion that fails on its face.
