
AMENDED SWORN AFFIDAVIT

1. My name is Charles Crawford and I filed a Petition for Rule Making proposing to allot channel 284A to Bertram, Texas on or about January 16, 2004. Based on my expression of interest, the FCC subsequently released a Notice of Proposed Rule Making, MB Docket No. 04-348, on September 3, 2004. And finally, on February 3, 2005, the FCC released a Public Notice which combined Docket No. 04-348 with Docket No. 04-407.

I have decided not to pursue the allotment of channel 284A at Bertram, Texas at this time and have therefore concluded to request that the FCC dismiss my Petition for channel 284A at Bertram, Texas.
