Madam Secretary:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral ex parte presentation in connection with the above-captioned proceeding.

On Wednesday, June 4, 2008, undersigned counsel, Hu Meena, Spence Flatgard, and Kevin Joseph, on behalf of Cellular South Licenses, Inc., met with Commissioner Adelstein, Scott Bergmann and Renee Crittenden concerning federal universal service reform. For the most part, the parties reiterated positions taken in the comments filed in the above-referenced proceeding.

The parties emphasized that the Commission should not eliminate IAS/ICLS support for wireless carriers, which comprises roughly 50% of all high-cost support for wireless. Suggestions that such support is merely "access replacement" ignore the Commission's Congressional mandate to move support from carrier rates into an explicit funding mechanism, which must then be made portable to any carrier delivering the supported services using any technology.

The parties also discussed the upcoming 700 MHz "D Block" auction and suggested that a nationwide network might be the best means of allocating the spectrum, to achieve a third

nationwide network. Such a network would foster competition in the roaming market, which is increasingly dominated by the two largest carriers. It was suggested that a form of installment payments could be instituted to enable regional carriers to have an opportunity to participate at the national level.
