Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, Discovery Communications, LLC ("Discovery") discloses two *ex parte* phone conversations that the undersigned, Director of Federal Public Policy for Discovery, held on Monday, June 9, 2008. The conversations were with (i) Rick Chessen, senior legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps; and (ii) Rudy Brioché, legal advisor for media issues, and Shawn Donilon, intern, to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein.

Discovery discussed HDNet's recent *ex parte* suggesting that Discovery has "thwarted" its ability to gain carriage on distributor platforms, and noted that it has previously rebutted these unfounded allegations in a November 2007 *ex parte* filing. A copy of that filing is attached.
