The purpose of the meeting was to obtain staff guidance with respect to TPT's efforts to obtain a new post-transition DTV channel for Station KTCI-DT. During the meeting, TPT raised the possibility that it might file an application consistent with the DTV rules for Channel 26, its currently assigned post-transition DTV channel, in order to protect its ability to continue operating after February 17, 2009. In view of the opposition of the State of Wisconsin - Educational Communications Board, licensee of Station WHWC-DT, Menomonie, Wisconsin, to TPT's Petition for Reconsideration of
