

## KRIV - Houston, TX

*This report covers the time period November 1, 2005 to October 31, 2007*

*(except where otherwise specifically noted).*

### I. PROGRAMMING:

- a. **Local Newscasts:** KRIV airs 29½ hours of local news each week, at the following times:

Monday - Friday: 5 a.m. - 9 a.m.

Monday - Friday: Noon - 12:30 p.m.

Monday -Sunday: 9 p.m. - 10 p.m.

- b. **Breaking News Stories:** KRIV broke into and/or preempted regularly scheduled programming on numerous occasions during the period covered by this report in order to bring its viewers breaking news or disaster information. This coverage included extended reporting on severe weather warnings, amber alerts, school closings, and other emergencies. A comprehensive list of cut-ins and crawls is attached as Exhibit 1.

c. **Local News Stories**

KRIV operates under the banner "News That Works For You" and delivers the latest news to viewers in the Houston area. Local news stories aired on KRIV during the report period focused on Hurricane Katrina and its aftermath, and local assistance to Hurricane Katrina evacuees.

Stories targeted at specific groups included extensive coverage of an assault on a special needs child at his school, and the subsequent introduction of legislation to combat such abuse in the future

*My Tech Guy* is an ongoing consumer series that provides information on electronic, internet and computer issues. *Fox 26 Investigates* is a series of reports about crime, corruption and abuse in the area; for example, a report aired about drug abuse in a Houston Correctional Facility; another story reported about stolen cars from New Orleans appearing on Houston streets.

KRIV also covered debates, town hall meetings and public forums including a KKK Rally, Evolution Debate, Hurricane Katrina Dumping, Congress Up All Night, a proposed gun law, debates among Democratic presidential candidates and another among Texas gubernatorial candidates and debate regarding illegal immigration.

II. **PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

PSAs aired (at no cost to organizations) during the period January 8, 2007 through January 21, 2007 totaled 181, for a total of 83:55 minutes. Topics included the MLK Day Parade and Open a Child's Mind

PSAs aired (at no cost to organization) for the period June 11, 2007 to June 24, 2007 totaled 184 , for a total of **82:45** minutes. Topics included: TV Rating Icon and Juneteenth Festival.

PSAs specifically targeting or requested by community groups or addressing local issues for the period January 8 through January 21, 2007 amounted to 12:30 minutes and included coverage of MLK Day Parade.

III. **PARTICIPATION IN COMMUNITY**

Both KRIV's and KTXH's on-air newscasters and behind-the-scenes employees have made a commitment to participate in the Houston community. The stations' employees take part in a variety of events and causes in and around Houston, such as:

Employees, including talent, participate on the boards or are members of diversity organizations including the Houston Hispanic Chamber, the Association for the Advancement of Mexican Americans, NAACP, Houston Citizens Chamber of Commerce, Houston Minority Business Council, American Women in Radio and Television, Houston Area Urban League and the League of United Latin American Citizens.

KRVI participates in quarterly Ascertainment Sessions in which members of the community are invited to give a presentation about their organization and then discuss issues of concern as citizens who live and work in the community. Some organizations invited to participate in Ascertainments are Partnership for a Drug Free America, Blueprint Houston, Rotary Club of Houston, Asian Pacific American Heritage Association, Latino Writers, Houston Area Urban League, MLK Parade Committee Member, Project Row Houses, and Houston Habitat for Humanity.

#### IV. WEBSITE

KRIV provides news and entertainment content on its website through text stories, photo, videos and blogs. Its morning news and noon newscasts are streamed live on the website, and all reports shown on the morning, noon and 9pm newscasts are archived in video format on the website for later on-demand playback by visitors.

*MyFOXhouston.com* also provides the latest weather and traffic news in text and graphical formats. In the FOXRAD Weather Sphere, users can click on their county to see the latest radar imagery and weather alerts as well as current conditions.

Another unique local element on the site is the predator Check Interactive, where visitors can see the latest coverage on local sex offenders convicted of additional crimes or who are wanted by police.

One of the most interactive elements of the website is a live webcast called *MyFoxHouston LIVE!* It is shown on the web every weekday at 4 p.m. It features some local news and off-beat stories. Visitors can interact with the hosts via blogs and chat.
