

## WTXF(WPIR), Philadelphia, PA

*This report covers the time period November 1, 2005 to October 31, 2007  
(except where otherwise specifically noted).*

### I. PROGRAMMING:

- a. **Local Newscasts:** WTXF airs **36.5 hrs** of local newscasts every week:

Monday – Friday: 5 a.m. – 9 a.m.

Monday – Friday: 11 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. (debut on 10/09/06)

Monday – Friday: 5 p.m. – 6 p.m. (debut on 1/22/07)

Monday - Sunday: 10 p.m. – 11 p.m.

Saturday – Sunday: 6 p.m. – 7 p.m. (debut on 10/06/07)

- b. **Breaking News:** WTXF broke into and/or preempted regularly scheduled programming on numerous occasions during the period covered by this report in order to bring its viewers breaking news or disaster information. This coverage included extended reporting on severe weather warnings, amber alerts, school closings, and other emergencies.

- c. **Local News Stories:** Provided below is a sample of local news stories aired during the report period:

- *Health:* Problem of teenage drinking; smoking ban in Philadelphia, and information on the Avian Flu.
- *Environment:* Report on the unsafe air quality of New Jersey, and the impact on local residents
- *Consumer:* A report card on local children's playgrounds
- *Crime:* How senior citizens are being scammed, and what to do about it; identification of locations where illegal drugs are being sold
- *Safety:* Emergency preparedness, and maritime security
- *Transportation:* Expansion of Philadelphia International Airport

- d. **Political Coverage:**

WTXF has devoted extensive coverage to political issues important to its views. During the report period, WTXF aired pieces about former New Jersey Governor Jim McGreevey, a report of the Iraq War, story on Usama Bin Laden, a gun control rally in Philadelphia, Philadelphia City Council vote on a smoking ban, transfer of regulatory control of cabs to

the Philadelphia Parking Authority, and a demonstration against violence by Chester High School students.

e. **Public Affairs Shows:**

*Fox Friday*: A weekly show, produced in-studio, airs on Fridays. Examples of stories covered are:

- Celebrating our Vets - A Veteran's Day Special focusing on local military heroes
- Year in Review: Fox 29's year-end special, highlighting the big stories that impacted the Nation and the region, including crime, sports, politics, and technology.
- Black History Month: Fox 29 hosts this special from the African American Museum in Philadelphia, focusing on milestones in black history, the trailblazers, the pioneers, the AME Church and the Freedom Theater.

f. **Local interest:** Programs of local interest aired during the report period are:

- Holiday Light and Sounds: Fox 29's Annual Special, focusing on the region's diverse holiday celebrations.
- People Helping People - Community Stories: a Christmas Day special focusing on what local families are doing to make a difference in the community
- Several locally produced programs, focusing on pre-season training camps for Philadelphia's professional sports teams, "Game Day" and post-game coverage
- Public League High School Basketball Championships

## II. PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS (PSAS):

For the January 08-21, 2007 period, **67:45 minutes** of free PSAs were aired on behalf of numerous organizations, such as Civil War Museum and Habitat for Humanity. For the June 11-24, 2007 period, **130 minutes** of free PSAs were aired on behalf of the American Red Cross, and many other causes.

PSAs specifically targeting or requested by community groups or addressing local issues for the January 08-21, 2007 period totaled **54:15 minutes** on behalf of local causes, such as secondhand smoke, childhood obesity and flu shots for the elderly.

## III. PARTICIPATION IN COMMUNITY

WPIR's management, on-air talent and behind-the-scenes employees have made a commitment to participate in the Philadelphia community.

WTFX is Presenting Sponsor of the five area Alzheimer's Association Memory Walks which raise awareness and funds to combat the disease. The primary campaign period is September 1 – November 30th (Alzheimer's Awareness Month). The five area Walks take place in Wilmington, DE; Lehigh Valley, PA; Atlantic City, NJ; Philadelphia, and Berks County, PA on Saturdays/Sundays in October/November. As presenting sponsor, the station provides air time for promotional announcements encouraging participation in the Walks and public service announcements providing information about the disease and Association services. FOX 29 produces stories related to Alzheimer's that air during newscasts. Station on-air and staff participate in all of the Walks as hosts/emcees..

Station employees serve on the boards of, or are active members of, professional and community organizations. They take part in meetings, events and other activities in and around the city, such as:

- Board Member, Pennsylvania Association of Broadcasters
- Board member, Camden Children's Garden
- Sunshine Chairperson, Cheyney University Alumni Association of Philadelphia
- Members of Philadelphia Association of Black Journalists and National Association of Black Journalists, Asian American Journalists Association and National Association of Hispanic Journalists

- Member, Cheyney University Alumni Association;
- Volunteer, Alzheimer's Association of Delaware Valley
- Volunteer tutor, Adult Literacy League

They also have served as hosts, moderators, panelists or speakers at a number of community events, including:

- Speaker, National Liberty Museum
- Guest speaker, North Philly Sports Association
- Emcee, Bucks County music festival 2007
- Emcee, Wilma Theatre Gala

WTXF also seeks community input. The station manager, news directors and the public affairs director meet regularly with community leaders and at their request. In addition, the station's general manager and community affairs director (as well as other departmental managers) regularly attend community events and meetings. At these events, community organizations present their issues of importance. That information is passed along to the news department by the community affairs director.

#### IV. WEBSITE

Fox 29 News provides local news and programming to the WTXF broadcast audience through its Web site, *MyFoxPhilly.com*, and through the mobile version of selected Web site content. Selected news stories and features broadcast on Fox 29 News are encoded as web video and are made available in archival form to viewers.

Streaming video of important news events is provided on the site, as well as a blog platform that allows station anchors and reporters to communicate directly with viewers.

The website offers traffic information from a third-party vendor, Metro Traffic, and selected live weather radar images provided by the National Weather Service. Weather forecasts are provided by Fox 29 meteorologists.

FOX 29 promotes the campaign on-air via promotional and public service announcements as well as news stories profiling local organizations that either give or need toys for children. FOX 29 promotes the campaign via its web site with a link from its home page to the Toys For Tots site.

**Coalition on Donation / Gift of Life "Dash For Organ Donor Awareness"** – FOX 29 is the media sponsor for the Coalition on Donation's "Dash For Organ Donor Awareness." The campaign period runs from March 15<sup>th</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>. The Dash takes place in Philadelphia. As media sponsor, the station provides air time for promotional announcements encouraging participation in the Dash and public service announcements providing information about organ donation. FOX 29 produces stories about organ donation that air during Good Day Philadelphia and the Ten O'clock News. Station on-air talent participate in the Dash hosts/emcees. FOX 29 promotes the Dash on its website via a link from its home page to the Coalition on Donation's site.

**Alzheimer's Association of the Delaware Valley "Chocolate Symphony"** – FOX 29 is the media sponsor for this annual spring fundraiser that includes a corporate gala and reception that raise funds for the Alzheimer's Association programs and services. FOX 29 ran several stories/segments during Good Day Philadelphia and the Ten O'clock News prior to the events in an effort to boost ticket sales. FOX 29 promoted the event on the air and its website, sent talent to the event to participate in various activities and covered the events on the newscasts.

FOX 29 promoted the event on the air and its website, sent talent to the event to participate in various activities and covered the events on the newscasts.

**Carnivale of the Dogs** – FOX 29 was media sponsor for this annual event which raises funds for local animal welfare and adoption agencies while matching homeless pets

with new owners. FOX 29 promoted the event on its air, provided on-air talent at the event and covered the day's events in news programming.

**American Red Cross Blood Drives** – FOX 29 hosts 2 annual blood drives for employees and viewers. We promote the Drives on-air and on our website.

**Philadelphia Cares Day** – FOX 29 fields a team of station staff for this annual event in which volunteers work at Philadelphia public schools doing everything from cleaning up and painting to organizing books in the library.
