

KSAZ/KUTP - Phoenix, AZ

*This report covers the time period November 1, 2005 to October 31, 2007
(except where otherwise specifically noted).*

I. PROGRAMMING:

- a. **Local Newscasts:** KSAZ-TV airs **40.5 hrs** of local newscasts every week:

Monday-Friday:	5-9am 12:00-12:30pm 5:00-6:00pm 6:00-6:30pm (Effective starting 7/31/06) 9:00-10:00pm 10:00-10:30pm
Saturday:	5:00-6:00pm 9:00-10:00pm 10:00-10:30pm
Sunday:	5:00-6:00pm 9:00-10:00pm 10:00-10:30pm 10:30-11:00pm (Sports Night effective 1/8/06)

The station also repeats some of the newscasts during the week, in order to offer its audience a flexible schedule for viewing the news.

- b. **Breaking News:** KSAZ and KUTP broke into and/or preempted regularly scheduled programming on numerous occasions during the period covered by this report in order to bring its viewers breaking news or disaster information. This coverage included extended reporting on severe weather warnings, amber alerts, school closings, and other emergencies. A comprehensive list of cut-ins and crawls is attached as Exhibit 1.
- c. **Local News Stories:** Provided below are examples of local news stories and special assignment stories aired on KSAZ during the report period:
- Sex, Lies and Videotape- An investigation into whether apartment complex managers are providing truthful information about their tenants, especially sex offenders.
 - Choking Game—Advice to parents on what to watch for before their teenagers mistakenly kill themselves while playing a choking game.

- Missing Graves-The story of one Phoenix family who could not find a relative's grave; KSAZ's investigation revealed that the body had been moved and the headstone had been misplaced.
- Other stories were aired, including a preview of the school bond issue

A comprehensive list of the station's local news stories is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

d. **Political Coverage:**

Both KSAZ and KUTP have devoted extensive time to coverage of political issues important to their viewers. Several speeches delivered by President Bush were broadcast live, including a press conference in Tucson, where Mr. Bush discussed border security. Former President Bill Clinton was interviewed live, and experts discussed the enactment of new state laws of interest to the local community.

KSAZ and KUTP covered local town hall meetings and debates, including:

- Scottsdale Council debate about commuter planes at the airport
- Southwest Conference meeting about illegal immigration
- Press conference held by Gov. Napolitano to discuss I.D. thefts
- Speech by President Bush in Tucson, discussing border security

A complete list of public affairs programming is attached hereto as Exhibit 3.

e. **Public Affairs Shows:**

KSAZ airs a 30-minute show every Sunday morning at 7:30 a.m., *Newsmaker Sunday*. The show discusses relevant community issues. A repeat aired on KSAZ through January 8, 2006 and then was moved to KUTP on Sunday mornings. Some of guests and/or issues covered in the report period are:

- Maricopa County Attorney Andrew Thomas
- Discussion about the Trump Tower proposal
- St. Mary's Food Bank
- Tsunamis

KUTP is the home of the Phoenix Suns, the local professional basketball team. During the report period, all home games were aired live, and pre-

game and post-game shows were produced in-studio and broadcast live. KUTP also presents an annual holiday special, "Yule Log."

f. **Local interest:** Programs aired of local interest during the report period included:

II. **PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS (PSAS):**

For the period January 8-21, 2007, KSAZ-aired **108 minutes** of PSAs on behalf of organizations and important local issues including Girls and Boys Town, high school dropouts, identity theft, and literacy. During the same period, KUTP aired 81:25 minutes of PSAs at no charge.

For the period June 11-24, 2007, KSAZ-aired 136:35 minutes of PSAs at no charge, about topics such as college education, dental care, Diabetes, drug abuse and support and fatherhood. During the same period, KUTP aired 90:55 minutes of PSAs at no charge.

III. **PARTICIPATION IN COMMUNITY**

Both KSAZ's and KUTP's on-air newscasters and behind-the-scenes employees have made a commitment to participate in the Phoenix community. The stations' employees take part in a variety of events and causes in and around Phoenix, such as:

- Host and steering committee member, Native Americans in broadcasting
- Principal for a day, Pinnacle High School
- Speaker and emcee, Walk to Cure Diabetes Awards Ceremony
- Volunteer, Phoenix Children's Hospital

Employees participate on the boards or are members of diversity organizations:

- Cesar Chavez Foundation
- Latino Institute
- National Association Hispanic Journalists
- National Association of Black Journalists

KSAZ and KUTP constantly gather information about the needs and interests of the members of their community, particularly through participation in ascertainment meetings hosted by the Arizona Broadcasters Association. These meetings bring together a broad mix of community leaders, including state and local government representatives, non-profit executive directors and key representatives from minority interest groups. A comprehensive list of ascertainments during the report period is attached as Exhibit 6.

IV. WEBSITE

Myfoxphoenix.com launched on September 15, 2006. A stand-alone staff is assigned to the site seven days a week, and other members of the News Department are required to contribute content on a regular basis. The site is primarily designed to provide the viewing audience with immediate updates on important news stories, emergency situations, weather warnings, election results and any other information relevant to the community.

News coverage includes live streaming of big events and breaking stories as well as taped material and text. "Web Alerts" appear on FOX 10 during entertainment programming directing viewers to the web when breaking news warrants.

The site includes comprehensive weather and traffic modules that provide information 24/7. The site has become a community forum, giving viewers and KSAZ on-air talent an opportunity to post stories, opinions, photos or other information. In addition, we have hosted a number of "live chats" giving users the opportunity to question experts on a variety of topics of interest (*i.e.*, the recent dog food recall, mortgage rate questions, *etc.*).

While complete local newscasts are not archived for future viewing, most long-form stories (packages and live segments) are archived for access on-demand. During the report period, the web site attracted 3,205,486 visitors and generated 21,696,474 page views.

b. Special Assignment Stories:

Bike Seat Danger--11/4/05 – You know those tiny little bike seats that most bikes have? If men sit on them too long, it could lower their sperm count and prevent them from having children.

Sex, Lies and Videotape--11/5/05 – A FOX-10 Investigation asks apartment complex managers if sex offenders live there. We compare their answers to public records to learn if the managers are being honest with renters or if the managers even know what is going on. This is a public safety issue of concern to many.

Choking Game--11/8/05 – More and more teens are playing with death by choking each other until they pass out...then hopefully revive. Problem is, sometimes they don't wake up. We give parents the signs of what to watch for before their teenager ends up killing himself.

Stone Scam--11/9/05 – We warn consumers about a stone called "Genuine Peridot" being sold at TJ Maxx retailers. The stones are not real. Consumers are being ripped off. Because of our investigation, TJ Maxx pulls the "Peridot" from store shelves.

I-Pod Porn--11/18/05 – We warn parents about downloadable porn videos their children can load on their I-Pods.

Missing Graves--11/20/05 – Do you know where your relatives are buried? Turns out, one Phoenix family can't find their long dead relative who is supposed to be buried at a Catholic Cemetery in Flagstaff –turns out the body was moved, and the headstone misplaced.

Miracle Water--11/22/05 – One man's quest to develop a cure for AIDS (and just about everything else) by growing fungus and algae in water which is later filtered for use. Two AIDS victims claim they are disease free after drinking the water.

Sin Stocks--11/27/05 – Many 401-K and other funds invest in sin: Pornography, gambling, alcohol etc...You may be taking part in promoting sin if you invest in one of these companies without your knowledge.

Mexico Plastic Surgery--11/30/05 – Many people think they can get a good deal on plastic surgery south of the border. True – they may save money, but we warn viewers about the potential serious plastic surgery mistakes that can lead to years of problems later.

Balcony Dangers--12/2/05 – Bars on various balcony railings may be set too wide, or too far off the floor, allowing infants to get through and fall to their death. We warn parents about this danger and how to check for it to protect their children.

Same Sex Domestic Violence--12/7/05 – Arizona women taking out orders of protection against their former girl friends – this is one way to protect yourself no matter what kind of relationship you are in.

Hoodia--12/8/05 – A diet drug called Hoodia is flying off store shelves...but does it work. We put it to the test and find out it is mostly worthless – warning consumers trying to lose weight not to bother.

Sweet Poison--12/17/05 – Do artificial sweeteners like Splenda and Aspartame present a hazard to your health? A growing number of researchers think so...so we warn consumers about the potential health risks of Diet Soda.

Help for Parents--12/19/05 – Where parents can go when they have out of control kids...we let them know what services and agencies are available to them.

Fire Safe Cigarettes--12/22/05 -- Cigarettes cause more house fires than anything – but is it possible to make cigarettes that burn themselves out quickly if not smoked? We find out – and explain to smokers where they can get them (if they must smoke, then might as well be safe about it).

Loud Toys--12/25/05 – Very loud toys can cause permanent hearing loss for children – we warn parents not to buy toys that are too loud.

The Right Dog--12/26/05 – How to get the right dog for your children – we warn parents about the breeds to avoid so your children are not injured.

Caffeine and Kids--12/30/05 – We are becoming a nation addicted to caffeine, and so are our children who now need a jolt of Joe to get their school day started. We warn parents about the dangers of caffeine addiction in kids.

Computer Limbs--1/3/06 – Phoenix company uses computers to create more accurate and functional false limbs – good news for people who have lost a hand, arm or leg.

Outsourcing Parents--1/4/06 – Help for parents when they need it is available...you can hire someone to help you with everything your children do, including midnight feedings, and teaching your child how to ride a bike. But is outsourcing parenting really a good idea – we warn parents about the possible pitfalls.

Found Money--1/6/06 – People have hundreds, even thousands of dollars in state accounts that the state is holding for them, and most don't even know about it. We explain how to check for money they may have coming and how to collect it.

Spot Bot--1/8/06 – This is a consumer product that claims to remove spots. We put it to the test so consumers don't end up wasting their money.

New Knee--1/9/06 – People who need a knee transplant now have a new option – instead of surgery they can get injections of a special gel every six months...saves a lot of money and grief.

4D Ultra Sound Warning--1/10/06 – Many new parents will get what is called a 4D ultrasound of their unborn children because it's cool...but some doctors are warning parents now that it may not be a good idea...the scan could be harmful to your unborn child. This story is a warning for parents to think twice before getting one.

Shredder Danger--1/11/06 – A warning for parents...if you are not careful your child's hand could end up in a shredder. They are very good at shredding not just paper, but little fingers too.

Sex on TV--1/12/06 – A recent report says sexual content on TV has doubled since 1998...we warn parents, and explain how they may need to change their approach to talking to their teens about sex, thanks to TV.

Gang Tattoos--1/15/06 – Phoenix Parks and Recreation is helping former gang members get gang tattoos removed at a substantially reduced price. Good information for people wanting to get rid of their gang affiliations or forget their gang past.

Pharming Parties--1/19/06 – We warn parents about teenagers who raid their medicine cabinets, and put all the pills they can find in a big bowl so they and their friends can have a pharming party...where everyone pops pills like candy.

Food Allergies--1/23/06 – Eleven million Americans live with food allergies, and five million children have serious cases. Are parents and doctors paying attention? We show parents what to watch for.

Rape Kits--1/28/06 – This story is about some Phoenix women trying to raise money so that more rape kits can be processed by Phoenix Police...and more rapes solved. We help them raise money by explaining where people can donate.

Airborne Cure--2/2/06 – We test an herbal product called “Airborne” to see if it really prevents a cold or flu...is it money well spent, or a waste of your hard earned dollars?

Chicken Pox Party--2/6/06 – Parents who don't want their young children to take Chicken Pox vaccinations instead expose their children at a chicken pox party to a child who has the illness...and just get it over with. Is this a good idea? Is having chicken pox at an early age better than taking a vaccine that prevents it for life? We warn parents about the possible hazards involved in this kind of strategy.

Bad Pillows--2/13/06 – If your pillows are more than a couple of years old, you might want to toss them. We find all kinds of bacteria in tests of older pillows, and they may present a serious health risk.

Shaken Baby Risk--2/15/06 – This story is about twins who are now young women, but one was shaken as a baby. The graphic demonstration of how their lives diverged from that point are on display – a warning to parents about what can happen if their baby is shaken violently.

Family Watchdog--2/25/06 – America's Most Wanted sponsors a new website everyone should know about – just put in your zip code and a map displays the

location of registered sex offenders in your neighborhood. Community information everyone should have to protect their family.

I-Pod Hearing Loss--2/28/06 – How can parents monitor the strength of the I-Pod volume when their kids are listening? If they are not careful, their children could suffer permanent hearing loss...because we test I-Pods at full volume, and the level is deemed dangerous by audiologists.

Turning 18--3/9/06 – The laws concerning your rights and responsibilities change dramatically when you turn 18 years old. With the help of a local judge, we explain to most 18 year olds, who don't know that anything changed.

Baby at Risk--3/16/06 – Some women decide to schedule c-section births for their children before reaching full term. Could it be they don't want to gain too much weight? Yes, it's true, so we warn women about the risks of this figure-saving procedure to the unborn child.

Home Surveillance Cams--3/19/06 – No longer for the rich and famous, average homeowners can now install security cameras to protect their homes too...we show people how much it costs, and how easy it is to install.

Moms on Meth--3/20/06 – Mothers are turning to meth to help lose weight after their baby is born. We point out the problems with this dangerous weight-loss technique that could end in addiction and jail.

Blind Golfer--4/2/06 – Inspirational story about a blind man learning how to play golf, and how other blind people can learn to play too.

Term Paper Posers--4/5/06 – Students thinking about that final term paper due in a few weeks should think twice about using one from an on-line source. Professors now have internet tools to catch them – warning to students and parents why it's not a good idea to cheat.

Student-Teacher Sex--4/6/06 – Report shows that student-teacher sex may happen more often than we know, especially between female students and male teachers...we warn parents about the dangers.

Ticket to the Game--4/9/06 – When was the last time you have a good ticket to a concert or game? Don't know how to play the game? We tell viewers some of the best ways to get good seats without being taken.

Teen Breast Implants--4/13/06 – Parents need to know when it's right or wrong to agree for their teenage girls to get breast implants.

Sports Contact Lenses--4/14/06 – Vision experts have designed contact lenses that work just for athletes...and are designed for specific games. So if your son is having trouble seeing a baseball in a little league game, this might be the answer for you.

Body Bugg--4/16/06 – New weight loss device you wear on your arm during the day, then you plug it into your home computer. The computer will tell you how many calories you burned during the day, and help you judge efforts at weight gain. Our tests showed the device worked well, but you still have to get enough exercise.

Cutting the Cord--4/20/06 – Many college students addicted to their cell phones are having a hard time cutting the cord emotionally with their parents. We explain how parents can help, if they want to.

Drowning Survivor--4/24/06 -- A young boy who nearly drowned in a day-care center swimming pool is doing better. We talk to his mother 4-years later, and find out if she has any advice for parents looking for day care.

Diabetes Treatment--4/24/06 – New treatment for diabetics that makes it much less likely they will lose legs or arms due to poor circulation. We explain to diabetics how it works, and how to get help.

Scent for Boys--4/28/06 – Young men in grade school and middle school are discovering the grooming market is targeting them. Parents are warned about their children spending money on body sprays and other grooming products. Why can't boys just be boys?

Consumer Info. for Sale--5/1/06 – With the help of a private investigator, FOX-10 News discovers a utility worker offering to sell private information. She boasts about having easy access to SRP customer's private security information, and she's willing to sell it. Undercover sting exposes just how easy it is for identity thieves to get information about you.

Leeches--5/2/06 – A local hospital now using leeches to help patients heal stubborn wounds and open cuts. The leaches provide a healing alternative for people who need help, and who haven't been helped through traditional methods.

Liposuction Alternative--5/3/06 – A Scottsdale clinic is now offering patients an alternative to painful and sometimes fatal liposuction. They are testing a new device for FDA approval that can smooth and contour skin without surgery.

Face Book--5/4/06 – Face Book is the online directory that connects people through different social networks. The problem is, most people don't realize that all the information they include on their Face Book page could be accessed by people who want to do them harm – this is a warning for parents about their children who may be at risk by going on Face Book without taking proper precautions.

Food and Violence--5/6/06 – New study links some foods to decrease in violent behavior...such as fish, rich in vitamins and fatty acids. Could this be a new way for jails to control inmates who exhibit violent behavior, or for parents to control out-of-control kids?

Medical Miracle--5/9/06 – Local energy healer Jerry Wills treats a man who was nearly beaten to death with a shovel. He tells us how Jerry "healed" him when doctors had just about lost hope that he would survive. Jerry and others like him represent alternative healing methods that appeal to more people every year.

Restaurant Bacteria--5/10/06 – A warning to anyone who eats at a restaurant about the germs that lurk on Salt and Pepper shakers, catsup bottles, etc. Scientists at the University of Arizona test the substances, and we warn consumers.

Supplements--5/12/06 – Do natural diet and energy supplements, like Ultra, actually work? We get professional opinions, and let consumers know what we discovered.

Diet Spray--5/17/06 – Chicago company invents a food additive spray...all you do is spray this stuff on your food and you will lose weight – supposedly. We let consumers know if there is anything to this.

Credit Card Receipts--5/18/06 – A very concerned garbage truck driver hands FOX-10 news a huge roll of cash register receipts thrown away by workers at Sam Goody...complete with names and credit card account numbers. This story is yet another warning for consumers that they may be at risk of credit fraud and not even know it.

Workaholics Anonymous--5/21/06 – We talk to a Phoenix woman who is a member of a local Workaholic group. We talk about the problem, and about who needs help, including the signs of workaholic issues.

McCain at Work--5/22/06 – We spend a day with the Arizona senator as he goes about his business in Washington DC...a bit of a civics lesson for viewers who have no idea what our Senators and Representatives actually do in a days work.

Miracle Drink--5/23/06 – The makers of a drink called Noni-Juice make some incredible claims about their product...it is supposed to cure whatever ails you. People sell it door to door, or you can buy it online. We have nutritional experts take a look and determine if there is anything to the claims.

Picture Perfect--5/26/06 – New digital cameras are not only easy to use, but some of them claim to actually make you look better. Is that true? We put some to the test and inform consumers about the camera's claims.

Fuel Optimizer--5/28/06 – New device claims it can increase your fuel mileage. But does it work? We put it to the test on several vehicles to let consumers know if it is worth trying out.

3D Mapping--5/30/06 – Local company produces 3-D image maps of local buildings for police and other first responders. The maps allow them to study a building before entering to end a hostage or terrorist situation...and quite possibly save lives.

ID Theft Secrets--6/2/06 – We hear from a man who knows all about how to rip off other people's identities – good tips for people trying to prevent it from happening to them.

Safe Tattoo--6/14/06 -- How to get a safe tattoo, and not put your life at risk. The story includes information about safe tattoos that could save lives.

Work or Not--6/15/06 – Many women have a tough decision to make after having a baby – do I stay home or go back to work? We take a look at the benefits of both to help women make the right decision.

Breast Cancer Thermography--6/16/06 – Story about new military technology being used to help cure breast cancer. Thermography, which was developed for the military for advanced night vision, maps out temperatures on the skin's surface. Now, it can be used to screen for breast cancer. We show women where to go to get the test that could save their lives.

4X4 School--6/19/06 – Learn how to drive that new SUV in your driveway before it kills you. Local class teaches people how to drive one safely...consumer safety story.

Monsoon Study--6/21/06 – Scientists at ASU and U of A receive a federal grant to study Arizona Monsoon thunderstorms – to help develop better warning models and potentially save lives by getting people out of harms way sooner.

Power Seed--6/25/06 – New product that is supposed to help people lose weight...but does it work? We put it to the test before consumers spend money on a worthless product.

Germy Phones--6/26/06 -- U of A researcher tests cellular phones and found that 20-percent of the phones were contaminated with MRSA, a dangerous anti-biotic resistant staph infection. Why it's a good idea to clean your phone once in a while.

New Fertility Treatment--7/3/06 – Good news for couples who can not conceive a child – a 4-Day Embryo transfer protocol increases the chances to achieve pregnancy from a single egg. We explain where couples can go to try it.

Rapid Response--7/4/06 – Doctors on call for a 24-hour rapid response team at one Valley Hospital – should you need urgent life-saving care.

Diet Drug--7/5/06 – First FDA approved weight loss aid for sale without a prescription. We explain how it works, and if it is right for you.

Sunglasses--7/10/06 – People often forget to protect their eyes from the dangers of the Sun – we explain why eye protection is so important, and which type of sunglasses work best.

Da Vinci Robot--7/18/06 – How a local hospital is using robotic technology to improve surgical incisions, allowing for a faster recovery time. Good consumer information about health care options available.

Laser Smoking Treatment--7/19/06 – Laser treatment that is supposed to help you quit smoking – we put it to the test to find out if it works.

Sex Addicts Anonymous--7/20/06 – People addicted to sex, and addicted to internet sex now have a place to go to get help. We explain how the therapy works, and where people can go to check it out if they think they have a sexual addiction problem.

Sudden Adult Death--7/25/06 – Sometimes people drop over dead for no reason...We talk to a local woman who dropped dead, but was revived and lives to tell the tale. Doctor's can't figure out what happened to her, but there are warning signs and we tell viewers what to watch for.

Miscarriage--8/1/06 – Using an MRI in a new way, doctors can get rid of lesions that cause baby miscarriages. We explain to viewers how it works, and where they can try it.

Flip Flops--8/9/06 – Everybody wears them, especially in the hot Arizona summer. But most people don't know they can ruin your feet...we show viewers what to watch for, and when not to wear them.

Too Much Yoga?--8/11/06 – Seems everyone is doing Yoga, but is there such a thing as too much of a good thing? According to one personal trainer, too many people are doing too much Yoga and getting injured way too often.

Auto Cool--8/14/06 – In a very hot, long, Arizona summer – there is nothing worse than stepping into a very hot car. But we put to the test a consumer product that is supposed to keep your car 15-20 degrees cooler while it is parked.

Medical ID Theft--8/15/06 – What do you do if someone steals your identity, then uses it to access your insurance and get free health care? We explain how to protect your medical identity.

HD Radio--8/20/06 – What is HD radio? Is it just another radio gimmick like AM Stereo...or does it really improve radio reception and quality? We put it to the test, and then inform consumers who may want to spend the money and give it a try.

Gold Scam--8/21/06 – One local man gets taken by promises of riches if he invests in Gold. This company convinces people to buy gold coins at ridiculously inflated prices. More than 20 people have already filed complaints nationwide...we warn consumers not to buy gold from this company.

Bad Heels--8/31/06 – Women in shoes during a long hot summer can mean only one thing...cracked, blistering and soar heels. We talk to doctors about a way to avoid this annual foot problem.

Family Friendly Websites--9/5/06 – We profile chat room and search engines designed by dads to keep their children safe from internet predators and porn.

Charity Scam--9/6/06 – Heated on camera discussion during this FOX-10 investigation, about a local charity that asks people to give \$50.00...but only \$5 goes to the charity itself out of every \$50.00 donated. We warn people not to donate to this fund-raising company.

Baldness Cure?--9/7/06 – Small hand held device you pass over your head everyday and it is supposed to help you grow hair. But does it work? We find out and brief consumers.

Missing Teenagers--9/11/06 – When teenagers are reported missing, police often dismiss the case as a runaway not worth their time. But one Phoenix family did the work needed to find their daughter and get her home. This story is a good lesson for parents not to give up should their teenager end up kidnapped or missing.

Proposition Preview--9/12/06 – We take a look at some of the more contentious propositions on the Arizona ballot in November so voters can make a more informed vote.

Rabies Risk--9/13/06 – If you spend a lot of time outdoors, you may want to consider a rabies vaccination. It is much easier than it used to be, and could save your life.

Diet Drug--10/2/06 – A product called “NV” on the market promises to help you lose weight and look more beautiful. Does it work? We find out and warn consumers.

Animal Testing Facility--10/6/06 – FOX-10 Investigation of a planned facility in Chandler that tests consumer products on animals. A lot of people in the area are upset about it, and want it closed. We try to inform viewers by finding out what exactly goes on in the company’s other plants in the US and Europe.

Cancer Walk--10/8/06 – A team of Phoenix men prepare for the Breast Cancer Walk in November – how viewers can participate as well is discussed.

Stage It--10/10/06 – A Phoenix company helps prepare your home so it is easier to sell...help for people who can’t sell their homes.

Disaster Kit--10/13/06 – Now you can buy everything you need to survive a natural disaster or terrorist attack in your own home. Some stores and websites now carry home disaster kits – we explain why it might be a good idea to have one, or at least prepare one for yourself.

Juvederm--10/22/06 – New way to keep looking young by using a product called Juvederm. It just got FDA approval. We put it to the test, and tell viewers if it is a product that could work for them.

Kid Safety--10/28/06 – After a wave of abduction attempts near valley schools, we show parents and their children how to respond should someone attempt to abduct their children.

Breast Cancer Surgery--11/5/06 – Some people think too many women are having their breasts removed for the fear of having breast cancer. Has this become unnecessary surgery? We take a look at the facts behind the numbers to help women decide if they should go through with it.

TSA stuff on E-Bay--11/8/06 -- All the things confiscated by TSA, including knives, a machete, sombrero hats, even fur lined hand-cuffs, are shipped off to a warehouse and then offered on e-bay. So we tell viewers to check e-bay every

Gift Card Traps--11/15/06 – A consumer warning about all those gift cards people like to give over the holidays. Read the fine print, some of them have expiration dates, or lose value the longer you wait to use them.

Home Schooling--11/17/06 – There has been a big increase in home schooling in Arizona. We give parents information that may help them decide to keep their children in school, or pull them out and teach them at home.

Coupons Online--11/19/06 – Local company sends coupons directly to your e-mail to help you save money. We explain it might be a service worth signing up for, because you can save at the grocery store.

Open Box Bargains--11/24/06 – Consumer alert about open-box items for sale at many stores, especially electronic stores like Best Buy. Can you get a good deal buying items taken out of the box, either for display or as returned items? Or are you taking a chance they might be defective?

Fake Coupons--12/1/06 – Consumer warning about people trying to sell bogus coupons – when you cash them in at the store, they don't work.

Computer Eyes--12/5/06 – Local inventor comes up with a way to control a computer just with the movement of your eyes – wonderful breakthrough for the disabled, who can not manipulate a keyboard or mouse.

Mosh Pit Warnings--12/7/06 – Warning to parents who allow their teenagers to attend rock concerts – a Mosh pit could be very dangerous to your health...this after a teen is seriously hurt in a Mosh pit melee.

College Internet Gambling--1/4/07 -- More and more college students are spending more and more money on internet gambling. We give parents the signs of what to look for that indicate their child may have a gambling problem.

Arizona's Most Wanted-Motorcycle Shop--1/6/07 -- A FOX-10 Investigation follows police as they pursue suspects accused of repeatedly shooting out the front windows of a local motorcycle shop.

21 Day Detox--1/9/07 -- We provide a roadmap for our viewers to follow on how to get on the track to good health after overindulging during the holiday season.

Credit Scores--1/10/07 -- A FOX-10 investigation warns consumers about a web site that promises to increase your credit score for a fee.

Stress Therapy--1/11/07 -- Holiday and post holiday stress can take its toll on the healthiest of people. We give viewers treatment options that use various audio and visual stimuli that induce the client's brain to relax.

Wedding Disasters--1/12/07 - After several couples lost their money after paying a wedding planner who went bankrupt, we warn future brides and grooms how to find a wedding planner who won't rip them off.

Therapy Dogs--1/21/07 -- Therapy dogs help children who are learning to read. The readers are less intimidated reading to a dog than they are to a teacher or their class, so they do better.

Gun Safety Mom--1/27/07 -- A local woman, who lost her son to an accidental shooting, leads a campaign teaching gun safety.

Dirty Purses--1/28/07 -- We warn woman about the dangers that are literally growing on the bottom of their purses. Purses that can wind up sitting on the table your family eats at or on the counter where your food is prepared.

Back Pain--1/29/07 -- We show viewers a new arthroscopic procedure that repairs disk damage without a long hospitalization.

Massage Safety--2/17/07 -- Following three arrests at a popular chain of massage parlors, we look into what steps local businesses take to make sure the people touching your body can be trusted.

Dog Insurance--2/18/07 -- We tell viewers why some insurance companies won't issue homeowner's insurance if a certain breed of dog will be living there.

Cindy McCain in Cambodia--2/19/07-- Fox 10 Anchor travels to Cambodia with the wife of Sen. John McCain. Mrs. McCain is there on a mission of mercy to raise awareness about the dangers of buried land mines leftover from the days of the Khmer Rouge.

Gas Can Robbers--3/24/07 -- Police asking for viewers help in finding a man wanted for kidnapping, aggravated robbery, burglary and arson in several western states including Arizona.

Bad Drugs--3/28/07 -- Police fear new designer versions of meth and other party drugs are about to hit Arizona in big numbers. We give viewers tips on what they can do to help stop the flow of the potentially deadly drugs.

Shopaholics--4/8/07 -- We warn viewers about the dangers of being a shopaholic. We give advice on how to spot signs of trouble with a loved one whose shopping habit can be as dangerous to them as too much gambling or drinking.

APV-6 Homeland Security--4/9/07 -- We explain the internet networking plan in effect that can link all first responders in an emergency or terrorist situation.

Texting--4/12/07 -- We look at the problem of local teens having their English skills in high school deteriorating by their use of shortcut symbols they use while texting.

Breast Cancer Survivors--4/19/07 -- We hear the stories of breast cancer survivors who all underwent the same new procedure... now available to all... to remove the cancer from their bodies.

Cellular Tracking--4/28/07 -- We explain the new technology in cell phones that can help police or rescue teams track you down even if you are incapacitated and can't call out for help.

Spelling Bee--5/27/07 – We talk to an Arizona family, whose children seem to make it to the National Spelling Bee just about every year. What is their secret? What can other parents learn from them?

Door Knob Cleaner--6/17/07 – Consumer alert story about a new device that hangs on a door knob and cleans it automatically between uses. It sprays the door knob with a disinfectant spray – and could be a good way to keep the workplace, even your home, more germ-free...and your family healthier.

Child Modeling Warning--6/18/07 – Consumer warning about child modeling agencies...sometimes, in their quest to be a star, children can fall prey to unscrupulous modeling agencies that turn models into child porn stars. What parents should watch out for.

Motorcycle Injuries--6/19/07 – With gas prices up, and clogged freeways avoidable by using the HOV lane, motorcycles are becoming more and more attractive...But there are serious health risks...and motorcycle related injuries are more common than ever. We report the risks involved when switching from car to motorcycle so viewers can make their own decision.

Free Medicine--6/23/07 – Consumer warning about a website offering free prescription medication...if you sent them \$199.00. The problem is, they only provide medicines offered free in the government drug program...drugs you could get for free yourself instead of paying this company \$199.00.

Child Bone Loss--7/3/07 – Children are at greater risk of bone loss than ever before. This story explains the problem, and describes warning signs to parents and what they can do about it.

Breakdown--7/5/07 – If your car is not properly maintained during the hot summer months – a breakdown might be much more than an inconvenience...it could be deadly if you are stranded outside for a long period of time. We explain how important it is to keep your care in shape this time of year.

MySpace Baby--7/6/07 – Mother is displaying the progress of her child – a victim of shaken baby syndrome – on the internet site myspace.com. This story is an excellent way for other people to witness for themselves how terrible this problem is...and to never, ever, shake their baby.

Obesity Camp--7/25/07 – A place for overweight children to get help. The FairWorthy Institute of Phoenix hosts a Camp LYFE for obese children. We show parents how it works, and how to get their overweight children enrolled.

State as Babysitter--7/29/07 – Parents beware – not even state licensed and operated day care centers are all safe. Our FOX-10 Investigation reveals the death of an infant at a state daycare center. Case is still in litigation, but it's a good example of what can go wrong if you are not careful picking out a daycare center.

Home Budget Help--8/6/07 – Local company helps people who have trouble organizing home finances. Before you get into credit trouble, you should contact this company or another like it – good consumer advice and help is available.

Unbreakable--8/9/07 – We test a product that claims to be unbreakable. Dishes, glasses and other dinner wear that you can't break. Good consumer alert on a product that delivers on its promises.

Door Jam--8/11/07 – Consumer alert – story about a product that claims it can keep burglars from breaking your door down. Does it work? We put it to the test...and yes, it does work!

Thunderstorm Electronics--8/13/07 – Is it a wise idea to operate I-Pods or other personal electronic devices during an Arizona monsoon thunderstorm - Probably not, according to the experts. This is all about protecting yourself in a severe electrical storm common here in the late summer months.

Second Life--8/28/07 – Phoenix man ruins his real life by having a digital affair on the alternative reality computer game "Second Life" – and his wife leaves him because of it. Consumer warning – these kinds of games can become addictive, and destroy your real life.

Purity Ball--9/2/07 – A purity ball taking place in Arizona is all about teen pledges to their parents not to have sex until they are married. Is this an effective way to prevent teen pregnancy or the spread of STDs? Some parents and teens think so.

Extreme Hydroponics--9/4/07 – Phoenix man invents a way to grow all kinds of vegetables on top of a black-top parking lot – using plenty of Arizona heat and very little water. It could be the key to save growing seasons as the Earth continues to warm up.

Job Coach--9/12/07 – Consumer story about services available to people who want to change jobs. We explain what a job coach does, how it may come in handy, and how to contact one.

Mine Rescue--9/13/07 – After a mine accident in which one young girl was killed – we investigate the dangers of abandoned open shaft mines across Arizona, and what the state is doing to make them safe.
