Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing on behalf of the Wireless Communications Association International, Inc. ("WCA") to confirm that WCA has no objection to a Commission grant of the June 13, 2008 request by the National EBS Association ("NEBSA") and the Catholic Television Network ("CTN") that the Commission extend by 75 days the time afforded for the filing of comments and reply comments in response to the *Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in this proceeding.

While WCA is anxious to see the Educational Broadband Service "white space" licensed rapidly, on-going discussions among NEBSA, CTN and WCA are occurring in an attempt to develop a consensus approach regarding this issue. Extending the deadlines for comments and reply comments until September 22, 2008 and October 22, 2008, respectively, will provide additional time for WCA to work toward such consensus over the next couple of months, which, if achieved, could actually allow the Commission to resolve the issues raised in the *Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* more quickly than if the current schedule is maintained.
