I am writing on behalf of our organization, Child Center~Marygrove, a not-for-profit agency with a mission of serving children, adolescents and young adults who have been traumatized by abuse and neglect. As the second largest residential treatment center in Missouri, every day in our program we serve without discrimination more than 130 intensive-need males and females ages 6 to 21. Child Center~Marygrove accepts children from Missouri and SW Illinois providing 24/7 supervised, residential care, diagnosis, therapeutic intervention and more.

Recently I was approached by the Bonneville St. Louis Radio Group/WIL/WARH/WMVN to be interviewed about our mission, the children we serve and the families we help with counseling, parent education programs and access to community resources. It is the intention of this radio group to air our agency's story to inform, educate and better serve the communities that Bonneville's stations reach. It is my understanding that this interview will be aired from time to time as a public service.

We appreciate this wonderful opportunity to remind those who know about our mission that we continue to need support for the traumatized youth we serve. But, perhaps more important, this is an excellent opportunity to tell our story to community members who may not be aware of our agency and its services.

The Bonneville St. Louis Radio Group fills a great need for us as we continue to raise awareness about Child Center~Marygrove and the investment we make in our children who are, after all, the future of St. Louis and all of Missouri. We do not think it advantageous or necessary for additional FCC rules and reporting regulations for federal oversight of broadcasters.
