Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Thursday, June 19, 2008, Lawrence Krevor, Vice President, Government Affairs – Spectrum, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”); James Goldstein, Director – Spectrum Reconfiguration Projects, Sprint Nextel; and I met separately with Bruce Gottlieb, Legal Advisor for Wireless and International, to Commissioner Michael Copps; and Wayne Leighton, Special Advisor, Wireless and International, to Commission Deborah Taylor Tate. Messrs. Krevor and Goldstein also met the same day with Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff and Senior Legal Advisor, Wireless and International, to Commissioner Robert McDowell.

We urged the Commission to grant Sprint Nextel's June 17, 2008 request for authorization to clear its interleaved, guard band, and expansion band channels (809-817/854-862 MHz) in stages, based on the region-by-region progress made by public safety licensees in retuning their systems to the new NPSPAC block.
