This is to notify you that on June 17, 2008, Dan Glickman and Fritz Attaway of the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc. ("MPAA"), and Edward Fritts of the Fritts Group, representing MPAA, met with Commissioner Michael Copps and Rick Chessen of Commissioner Copps' office regarding the above-referenced petition ("Petition). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss MPAA's request, as detailed in the Petition, that the Commission waive Section 76.1903 of its rules in order to facilitate the creation of a discrete distribution window to enable the introduction of new high-definition services to consumers.
