On June 19, 2008, I met with Catherine Bohigian, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis regarding the aforementioned proceedings covering a range of issues.

During the course this conversation, we discussed matters previously filed in the comments of Free Press in these dockets. In particular, I noted our continued opposition to the merger of XM-Sirius and our strong concerns about the DOJ's flawed competition analysis. We also discussed network management issues, our petition for declaratory ruling on the Comcast-BitTorrent matter, and the position of consumer groups that this is a case of signal importance that should be resolved in a timely manner. We briefly discussed our support for the resolution of the AWS-3 service rules in a timely manner so that this spectrum may see a useful, public interest purpose as soon as feasible.
