Wade Lindsay of my office, met with Matthew Berry, General Counsel, Michele Ellison, Deputy General Counsel, Ajit Pai, Deputy General Counsel, James Bird, Senior Counsel, Marilyn Sonn, Assistant General Counsel, and William Scher of the Office of General Counsel. We discussed NAB's position that the Commission may not lawfully act on the above-captioned merger application until after certain documents relating to the apparent serious wrongdoing by "executive and senior-level employees" of XM Satellite Radio Holdings, Inc. and Sirius Satellite Radio regarding the operation of FM modulators/transmitters and/or terrestrial repeaters are made public and incorporated into the record of this proceeding.
